

Nursery Summer Curriculum Flyer 2018

This flyer will show you some of the key learning opportunities that we will provide throughout this term in Nursery. We will be learning about Summer, as well as noticing and responding to things that the children are interested in.

<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> <p>To develop our oracy skills we will begin to recognise rhyme and rhythm in spoken words and join in with rhyming activities. We will also be working towards improving our reading and writing by using mark making across a range of contexts, supporting the children to attribute meaning to their marks and drawings.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Numeracy</p> <p>We will be building on our maths skills by consolidating how to count objects reliably through games and family group activities. We will also explore 2D and 3D shapes through our play and begin to recognise and name them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Knowledge and Understanding of the World</p> <p>During the Spring term, the children helped to enhance our outdoor garden by planting seeds and bulbs. This term we will observe the changes that happen to the plants, measure their growth and find out what mini-beasts are living in our outdoor environment.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Personal and Social Development</p> <p>This term we will support the children to develop their independence and confidence to try new experiences. We will help them to understand the expectations and routines of school, in preparation for the children that will be transitioning into Reception.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Welsh</p> <p>We will become more familiar in understanding and answering questions in Welsh such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sut wyt ti? • Pwy wyt ti? • Pa liw? <p>We will also develop our ability to count to 5 in Welsh.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Creative Development</p> <p>This term we will be developing our understanding of music through exploring different instruments and the sounds that they make. The children will also develop their understanding of colour, line, tone, texture, pattern, shape and form through observational drawings and other art, craft and design experiences.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Physical Development</p> <p>Through small group activities we will begin to understand rules and work towards being able to play simple cooperative and competitive games. We will also develop our fine manipulative skills through activities such as moulding clay, puzzles, block play and tweezer games to prepare the muscles in our hands for writing and drawing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">ICT</p> <p>We will be using ICT on our iPads to explore a variety of different apps and games, with support, begin to use keys to type familiar letters and numbers and take photos independently.</p>
