We informed Y2 parents this week that we have had reported cases of head lice among children. It would appear that treatment may not be being applied correctly as there have been a number of reported cases in the same class since.

I thought I would send this letter to the whole school as I have been made aware of the NHS Wales "Common Ailments Service", which could help with the financial costs of treatment.
