1- Draw 5 snowmen and generate a number within 50 to write on his scarfs. Children to add 10 more to this number and record this number on his hats. Use the 100 square below to help solve problems of finding 10 more (jumping down the number line in tens) Record as a sum underneath.

- 2- Draw 3 snowman and generate a number within 20. Children to add 10 more to this number and record this number on his hats. Use the 100 square below to help solve problems of finding 10 more (jumping down the number line in tens) Focus on recognising and recording teen numbers. Record as a sum underneath.
- 3- Draw 3 snowmen and write numbers 3, 5, 8 on his scarf. Children to find 1 more and 1 less using a number line below and record this number on his hat. Record as a sum underneath.
