Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all safe and well.

You will have heard that the Welsh Government have announced the plans for schools across Wales:

- Schools will increase operations from **29th June 2020**
- Schools will be open to all year groups, **for limited periods**
- **Only a maximum of a third of pupils** will be in school at one time
- All children will have the **opportunity to “check in, catch up & prepare”**
- Schools and local councils will make their own decisions on how this is managed
- The summer term has been extended by a week with **term ending on Friday 24th July**
- The autumn term half term break will also be extended by a week

With social distancing measures still very much in place, arrangements have been made in school to help children and staff stay at a safe distance. Please note however, we cannot guarantee that your child will not come into closer contact with others.

These are going to be very challenging times while we embark on the phased re-opening of schools. These arrangements may well be not what you expected.
