You will have heard that the Welsh Government have announced the September re-opening plans for schools across Wales.

With social distancing measures still very much in place, schools have been asked *try to minimise the number of contacts between learners* and group pupils by 'contact groups' so as to minimise the risk of transmission.

The attached information is an update of the information previously shared with you when we re-opened in June. **PLEASE NOTE: This is subject to change**, depending on advice and guidance from the WG between now and when we return. I will write again on the 1<sup>st</sup> September with any updates once the full re-opening risk assessment is completed.
