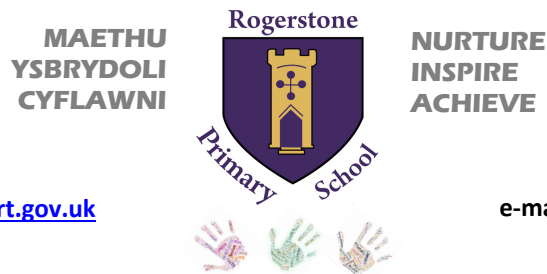

Dear Parents/Carers,

Many, many thanks for your cooperation in making drop-off and pick-up so successful these last 2 days! I'm sure you're all racking up the steps going around the one-way system!

It's been lovely to see all the children back and happy. We welcomed our new reception children Thursday and Friday, who came into school for a short visit before they start tomorrow. We will be welcoming our new nursery families next week. You will see a coned queuing area outside the nursery entrance which we will use while we are only able to have one child and parent at a time into the nursery foyer. We're looking forward to seeing you all next week!

A few tweaks and reminders for next week:

- The pedestrian gates by the 3G pitch will be opened at 8.40 and 2.45 each day for use. Please follow the path and join the one-way system if you use these gates.
- The school buses will leave the site at 3.35pm each day
- Please can you clear the car park without delay once you have dropped-off or collected to avoid congestion

Masks – If your child is wearing a mask in school, they must understand how to use them safely. A number of children who keep them on all day are touching them, pulling them down and fiddling with them around the mouth area. We have carried out some work with the children on how to use them correctly and safely and we would be grateful if you could remind them too. Children who wear re-usable masks who take them off in the class, must put them into a plastic bag and put them in their own bag/pocket and not leave them on the table, as some children have.

Nuts – please do not send any product into school that contains nuts. We have a number of children and staff who have severe nut allergies

Quarantine – if you have returned from a country that is not on the Government's exemption list, please ensure you follow the 14 day quarantine period and inform the office.

KS2 end of day – KS2 children are normally released without the need for an adult to meet them at the classroom door. Only Y3 and Y4 parents are normally asked to confirm this arrangement in writing. Owing to the staggered finish times, if your child is in Y3,4,5 or 6, please email the year group email with your permission and time you would like them to leave (i.e. anytime
