You will have all seen this notice in the last newsletter. I have had a number of parents comment on the queue at the end of the day at the gates. It doesn't seem to matter what time we say the gates will open, parents always seem to want to come and start queuing half an hour before we open them. 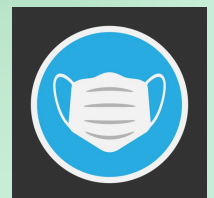
