More dates will follow as the term goes on. Don't forget to change the list on your notice board, fridge, diary or where ever you keep it, as it updates with each edition of the newsletter.



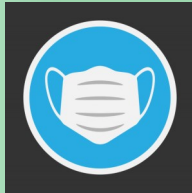
I'm not sure if there was a problem with the link to the parent feedback form that I shared before half term, but there have only been 10 responses.

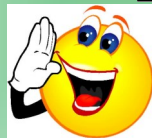
