

Literacy:

We will be recapping basic punctuation skills and reading response activities. As well as focusing on adventure and mystery stories. This half term we will be looking at the story clip 'Taking Flight'.

Areas of Learning Experience:

This term we will be looking at the history of Newport. We will explore the amphitheatre, the chartists, the transporter bridge and look at how Newport schools have changed over the years.

We will be focusing on the following Areas of Learning:

Science and Technology:

We will be exploring our new polytunnel which is based outside the year 3 classrooms as the weather gets warmer. The children will learn to grow, look after and potentially sell fruit and vegetables grown inside here. Children will also have a topic takeover day to build bridges using a range of resources.

Humanities:

To research a known place in Newport and note down ideas. Create a Google Slides presentation and present to the class (in groups of 4/5). Where is Newport? Ensure children understand that we live in Newport and South Wales - discuss language and culture.

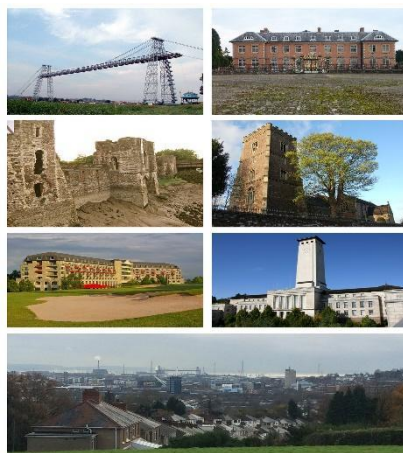
Expressive Arts/Music:

P.E.:
