Dear Parents/Carers,

To celebrate St. David's Day in KS2 this year, we will be having an Eisteddfod competition on Monday 2nd March.

The children will be entering various competitions in school, earning points for their houses and trying to win the Eisteddfod Cup! There will also be an opportunity for your child to earn extra points for their house by completing additional activities at home. Entries need to be handed in on **Monday 23rd February**. We are asking that all children complete a minimum of one and a maximum of three of all of the following 4 options:

- **1) Art competition**
Years 3 & 4

Create a garden scene in the style of Welsh artist Sue Williams. You can use any media on card, paper or a canvas.

- **Years 5 & 6**

Create a landscape in the style of the Welsh artist David Barnes.

- **2) ICT competition**

Create a poster, powerpoint or video about why you are proud to be Welsh/living in Wales.

Please send completed IT entries to your child's class email by Monday 23rd February.

- **3) School-based competition**

Welsh recitation - perform a Welsh poem.

The children will have the opportunity to learn/rehearse their class poem during their Welsh lesson next week.

All classes will also have the opportunity to practise with their class teacher during Daily Welsh).

We will be looking for good expression and accompanying actions. Props may be used to enhance the performance if desired.

A paper copy can be sent home (on Thursday 12th February) with pupils wishing to enter so that they may practise at home over the half term if desired.

Double points will be awarded for any pupils entering this competition.

- **4) Optional competition**

Musical instrument competition - Children who play a musical instrument will have the opportunity to earn additional house points by playing their favourite piece of music. Judging will take place in classes during the first week of school after the half term holidays. Please ensure that children have both their instruments and music in school from Monday 23rd February onwards.

The children will all be competing in a Handwriting competition within their classes and Y6 will also complete a Bardic entry.

Children are invited to wear traditional Welsh costume, Welsh rugby kits, Welsh football kits, or the colours within the Welsh flag to school on the day. Please note that children will not be wearing house colours.
