Dear Parents/Carers,

During the summer term children from year 2 to year 6 have undertaken statutory personalised assessments. These are online assessments for numeracy procedural, reading and numeracy reasoning (Year 3 - 6 only).

Personalised assessments are designed to provide information about your child's strengths and skills. These assessments are adaptive which means that every learner has a unique assessment. Questions are chosen based on the learner's response to the previous questions. If a learner answers a question correctly, they will get a harder question. If a learner cannot answer a question or answers incorrectly, they are given an easier question. This tailors the level of challenge for every learner.

You can access feedback on the assessments by logging into your [child's Hwb account](#), or searching hwb.gov.wales, clicking on personalised assessments and then learner feedback. Here you will be able to view feedback and progress for your child for the assessments which they completed this term. In our continued efforts to support the environment these will not be sent home in envelopes or laminated. Pupils will be asked to safely store them in a small pocket in their school bags.
