A Message From Mrs Price:

Thank you to all parents and carers for your understanding and support when we had to make the difficult decision to close the school due to the extreme weather conditions. Temperatures in some areas of the building, including the hall, reached very high and unsafe levels. We are also very grateful for your flexibility and positive response on Friday when we needed to adjust our pick-up arrangements at short notice.

We would still like to remind everyone of the importance of staying sun safe and well hydrated. Please ensure children come to school with water bottles, sun hats, and appropriate sun protection so that they can remain comfortable and ready to learn.

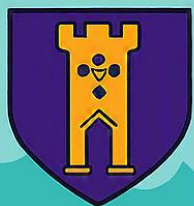


A great big thank you!

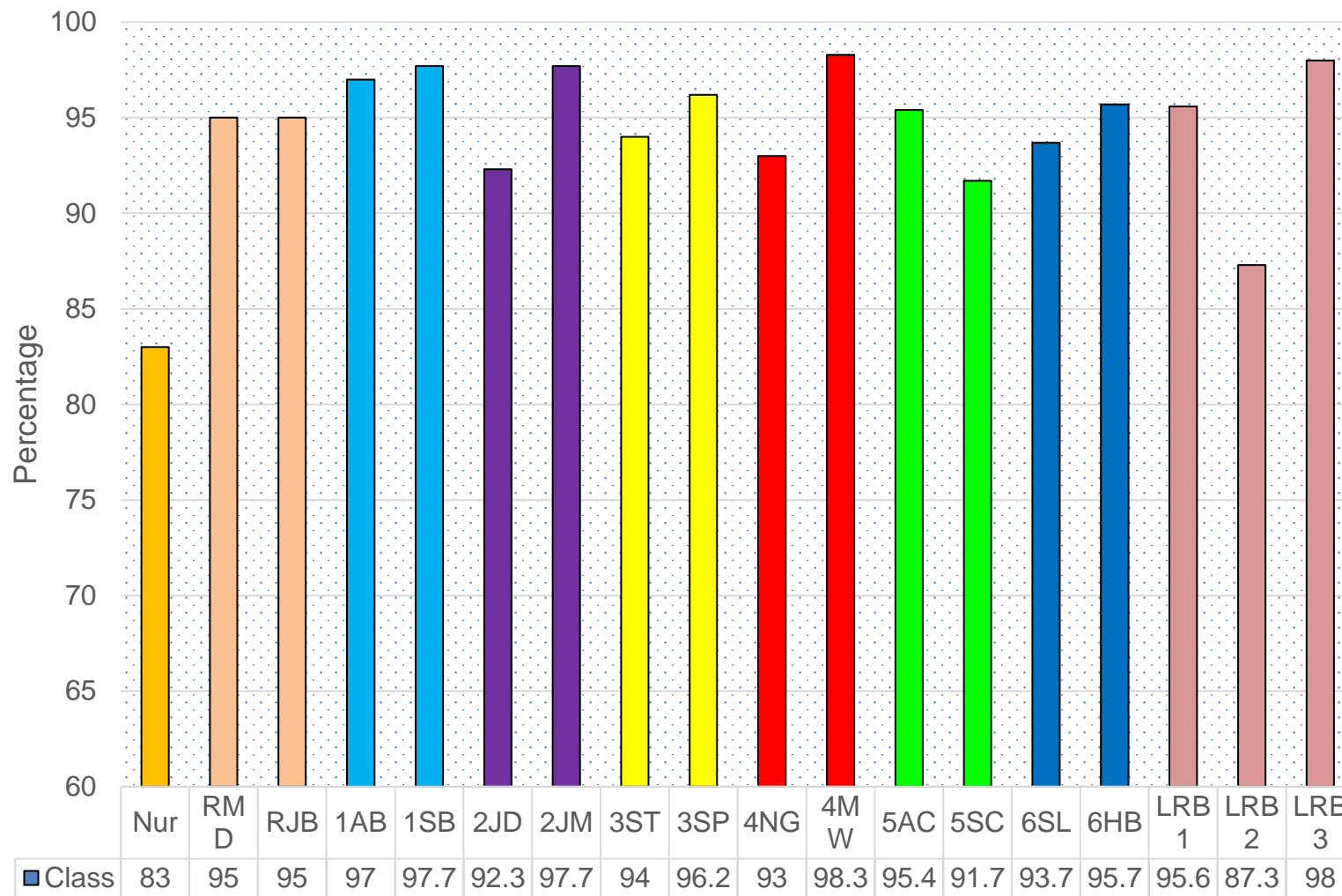

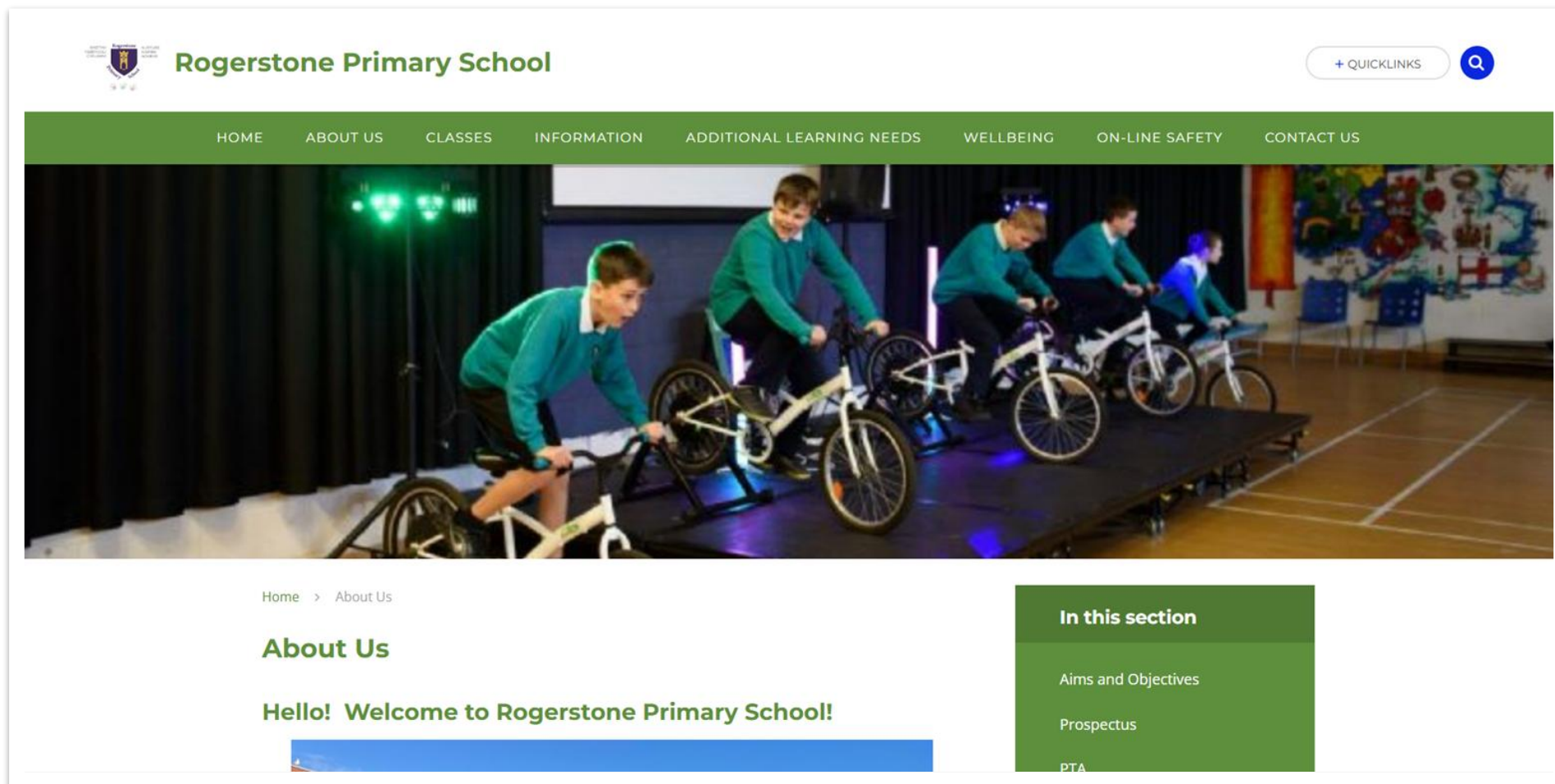
