School Bags and Personal Belongings

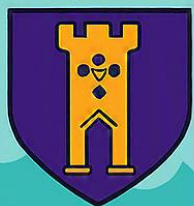
In a change to previous years, all reception and secondary applications in the normal admissions round should be submitted to the council, even if one of the school preferences is a faith school.

A serious loss of learning which is likely to have a detrimental effect on your child's achievement and life chances

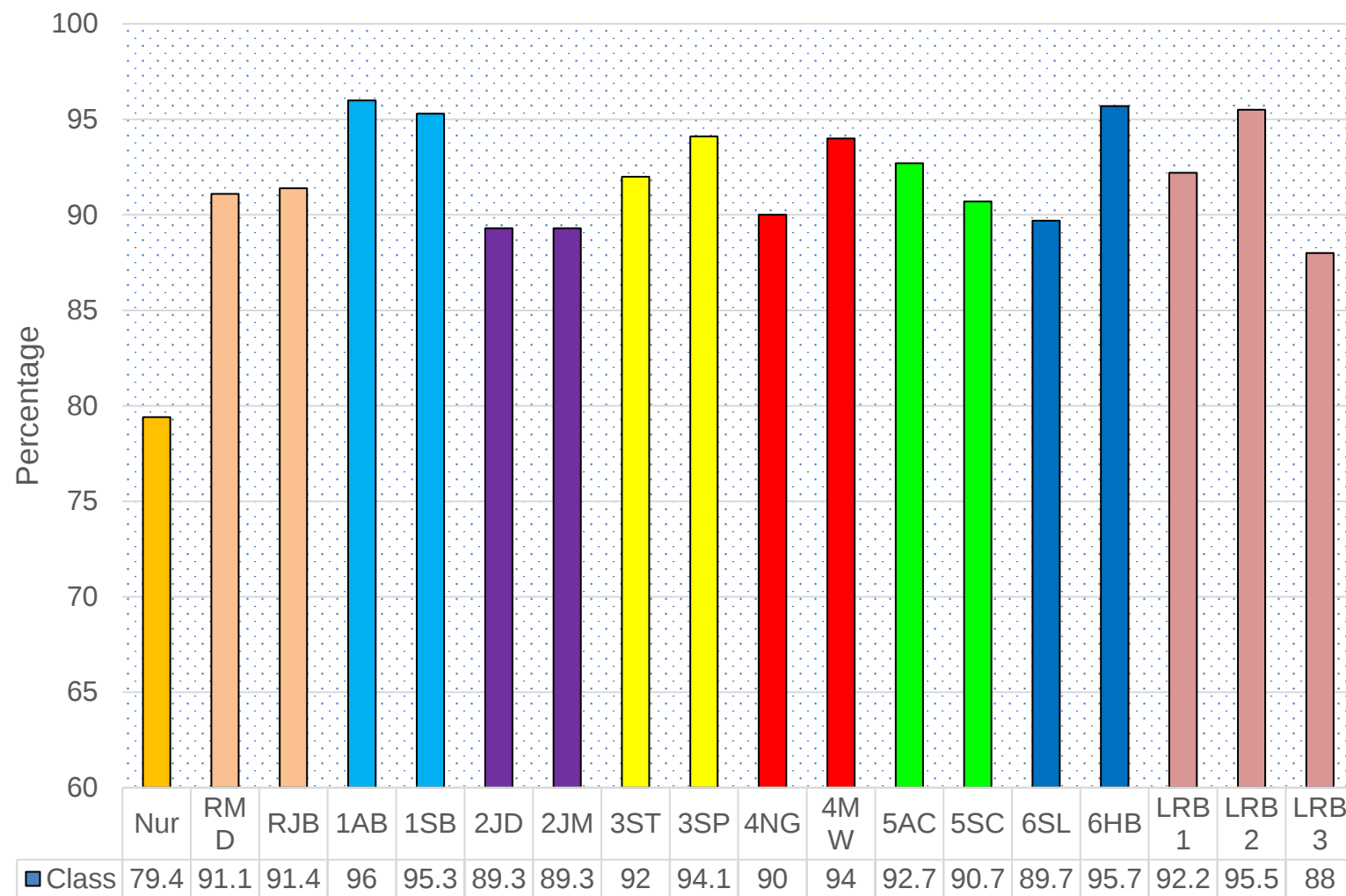

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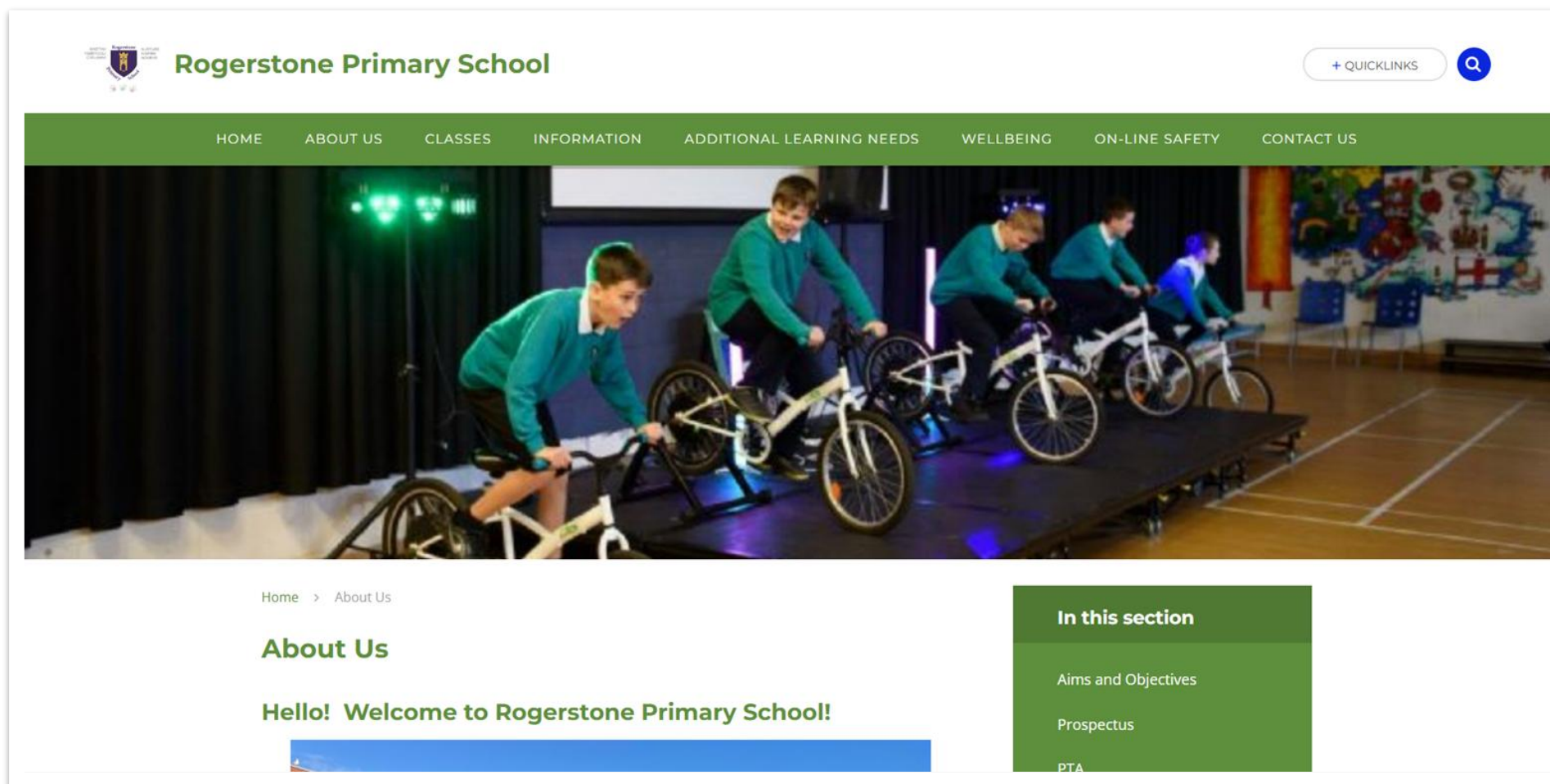
