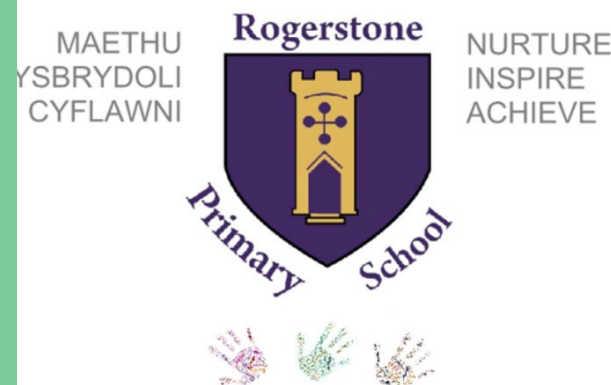


Rogerstone Primary School Newsletter

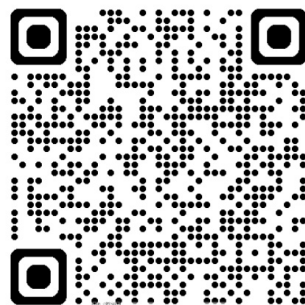

- Decide which schools to apply for - the more, the better
- Apply on-time

In a change to previous years, all reception and secondary applications in the normal admissions round should be submitted to the council, even if one of the school preferences is a faith school.

Nursery applications for a faith school should be submitted directly to the relevant school.
