Please note the days that we would like the children to bring a packed lunch in next week, due to various things taking place.

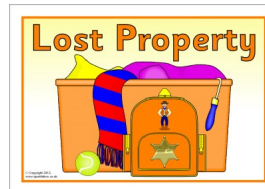
